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THE IMPORTANCE OF QUALITY ASSURANCE

 "Education is the key to the progress of a nation. There is no developed nation that is not supported by a strong education." [Joesoef 2021].

 The progress of education is inseparable from the implementation of a good, consistent, and sustainable quality assurance process for education.

 The purpose of quality assurance is to ensure that higher education reaches the set standards, namely the Indonesian national higher education standards (SN-DIKII).



HE Quality Assurance Agencies in Indonesia

- BAN-PT (NAAHE) is a national higher education accreditation institution established by the government in 1994 based on the mandate of the Indonesian Higher Education Act.
- The BAN-PT, is authorized to improve the quality of higher education, introduce and disseminate the "New Paradigm in Higher Education Management", and improve the relevance, academic atmosphere, institutional management, efficiency, as well as sustainability of higher education.
- As an external quality assurance institution, BAN-PT implements accreditation for Higher Education institutions.




HE Quality Assurance... (cont.)

- The Indonesian government subsequently established an Independent Accreditation Agency (IAA), the first being an independent accreditation agency in the field of Health sciences abbreviated as LAMPTKES in 2015. At the end of 2021, 5 IAAs were formed, namely LAMDIK (Education), LAMSAMA (science and mathematics), LAMEMBA (Economics, Management, and Business), LAMINFOKOM (informatics and computers), and LAMTEKNIK (Engineering).
- LAM is given the authority to carry out accreditation of study programs based on their respective scientific groups.

Equalization Mechanism for International Accreditation of Study Programs by BAN-PT

- ❖ BAN-PT only considers international accreditation agencies that have received recognition from the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology [Minister Decree Num. 83/P/2020].
- The results of international accreditation that can be equated with the rating of Excellent accreditation are full accreditation or general accreditation or accredited.
- ❖ To ensure that the National Higher Education Standards (SN-Dikti) are exceeded by Study Programs that have achieved full or unconditional international accreditation, BAN-PT requires that the Study Programs have been accredited at least Very Good by BAN-PT and/or Independent Accreditation Agencies.
- If all the requirements for equalizing the results of international accreditation of study programs are met, then BAN-PT will determine the equivalent with an Excellent Rank.

Preparation for Realizing the LAM-PTKes Internationalization Program

- ✓ An International Accreditation Team was formed, consisting of the President of SEARAME, Medical Assessor, Administrator, and Head of Division.
- ✓ Obtaining permission from the Minister of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology to carry out internationalization accreditation.
- ✓ Inform the Ministry of Foreign Affairs regarding plans to accredit in Vanuatu.
- ✓ Inform BAN-PT and ask for implementation support.
- ✓ Preparation of International Accreditation Handbook/Instrument (For Program Studies and Assessors), stages of the accreditation process, international accreditation management system.
- ✓ International Assessor Training (Domestic 24 (Dr & non-Dr), Malaysia 2 Dr, Thailand 2 Dr).
- ✓ Prepare Bali Meeting (meeting of SEARAME members and ASEAN QA Institutions).




Indonesian Accreditation Board for Engineering Education [IABEE]

- IABEE is an independent non-profit organization established to foster
 a culture of quality in the management of higher education in the
 fields of engineering and computing.
- IABEE was formed with guidance by JABEE (Japan Accreditation Board for Engineering Education), which has the status of a signatory to the Washington Accord..
- National accreditation by NAAHE/IAA is mandatory for study programs in accordance with Indonesian laws and regulations, while international accreditation by IABEE is optional.
- The eligibility of a study program to apply for an evaluation process to obtain IABEE accreditation is determined, among other things, by its National Accreditation status.

CLOSING NOTES

- BAN-PT in time will only focus on the mandate given in the implementation of the accreditation of higher education institutions.
- BAN-PT's collaboration with international quality assurance networking will continue to be fostered to increase international recognition.
- BAN-PT encourages and supports LAM to be able to play a global role, gain trust and recognition in carrying out international accreditation as pioneered by LAMPTKES.
- □ IABEE which was established in Indonesia has received the status of a signatory to the Washington Accord in the field of engineering and computing, so that its position is equal to other international accreditors.
